Who is Eligible?

Any Veteran, immediate family (spouse, under 18, or disabled adult living with the Veteran) Caregiver, or Surviving Spouse who is in need of transportation (even just once) within the 13-county Alamo region.

Where Can I Go?

Our primary goal is to help those needing medical care or services first, but you can use the program to do almost anything, such as:

1. Doctor Visits (not just to the V.A.)
2. Grocery Needs
3. Government offices
4. Trips to a senior center or community agency

How Does It Work?

1. Eligible person requests ride by calling 210-362-5254 or 1-800-960-5201, email vetrides@askasc.org or is referred by a social worker, case manager or other advocate.
2. AACOG staff assists the rider with:
 - Information needed to provide the rides (NO forms for the rider to fill out!)
 - Verifying eligibility through proof of military service documents or VA ID
3. Rider is approved and provided contact number for transportation provider in their area or assistance in scheduling a ride
(please allow 7 to 10 days prior to ride request)
4. If eligible, ride is provided FREE of charge
(Number of trips allowed is based on funding)
